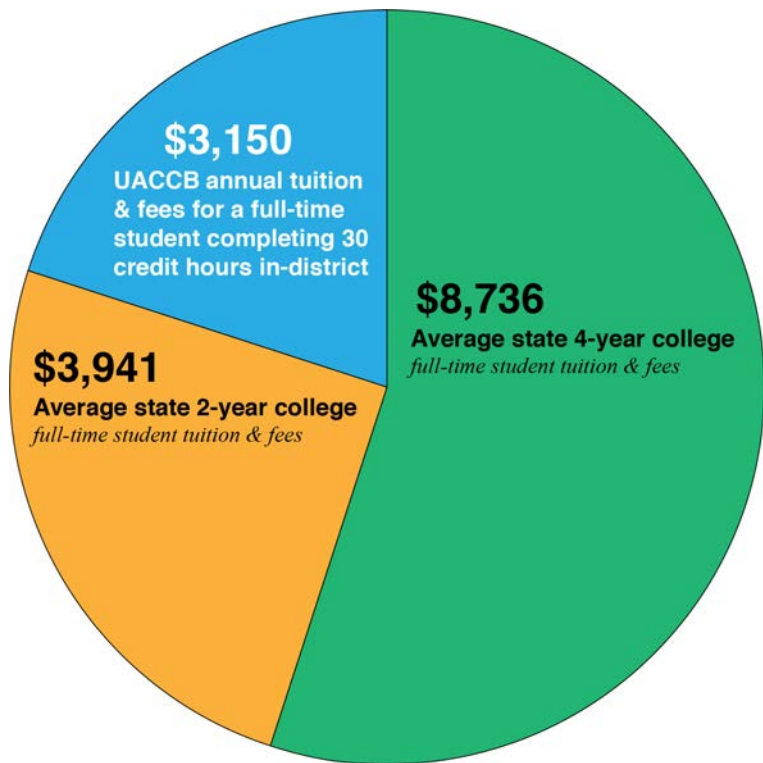

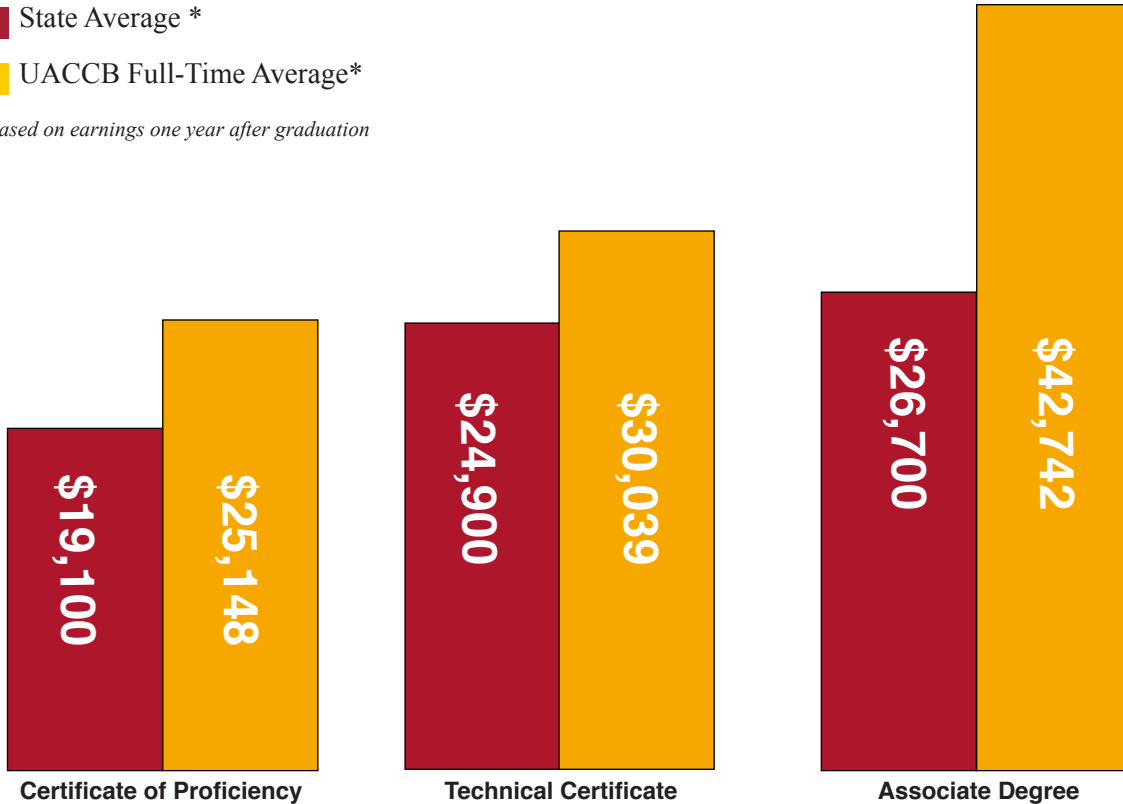



## 2018 First Year Earnings - Arkansas Economic Security Report 2019

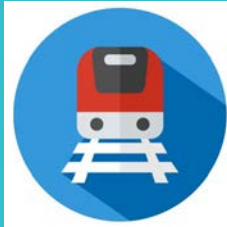

*UACCB accepts ACT, SAT, Compass, Asset, and Accuplacer scores taken within the last five years.*



## **Official High School Transcript**

*The transcript must include date of graduation or results of the General Education Development (GED) test. Also submit any previous college transcript(s). The high school transcript requirement can be waived if the student transfers 12 or more hours from a previous college.*



## **MMR I & MMR II - Proof of Immunization**

*Must provide documentation with dates of immunizations for measles, mumps, and rubella OR provide exemption paperwork from the state health department.*
