Pathway to Applying to the Nursing Programs at UACCB

Do I meet the requirements for the RN Nursing Programs at UACCB?

- 1. Cumulative college CPG of 2.75 or higher on a 4.00 scale
- 2. Have a grade of "C" or better on all perquisite courses to be awarded credit
- No more than eight (8) credit hours of pre-requisite courses to be completed during the summer session preceding the start of the nursing program for Prelicensure RN Entry Option unless approval by administration.
- 4. No more than eighteen (18) credit hours of pre-requisite course to be completed during the fall session preceding the start of the nursing program for the LPN to RN Entry Option unless approval by administration.
- Have a letter of good standing if I have previously attended an RN program on official letterhead from that school send to the UACCB NAH Department.
- 6. If my science courses are greater than 5 years? All science courses must be within 5 years of application semester. Exceptions: Completed an LPN program within the past 12 months or have at least 1200 work hours per past year as an LPN providing direct patient care.
- 7. If my computer software application is greater than 5 years? The College requires that you retake the course.
- 8. Be a resident of Arkansas If so, precede to Step 1.

Bring or Send the following items: Official Transcripts/GED, Copy of immunization records showing at least 2 MMR shots and Test Scores (ACT, etc.) Step 2: Go to fasfa.gov to apply for federal financial aid- school code: 014042

Step 3:

Complete RN Nursing Application Online at <u>https://nursing.uaccb.edu</u> the deadlines are: March 15 – May 1 (Generic RN Entry Option) June 1 – July 15 (LPN to RN Entry Option)

Step 4:

Set up a HESI A2 Date (Dates listed on website at <u>www.uaccb.edu</u> Go to: academics, divisions and programs, Nursing and Allied Health, RN, HESI Dates! The secretary of NAH will contact you once she receives a completed application.

Step 5:

Score at least a 75% or higher to be considered for admission. Admission is based upon a weighted point system which can be found at www.uaccb.edu
